



Anti-Trust Statement

All Global Insurance Fraud Summit, LLC participants must be mindful of the constraints of all appropriate antitrust laws, with the understanding that the Global Summit involves multiple nations across the globe.

At no time shall there be any discussion, nor any agreements or concerted actions that may restrain competition. This prohibition includes the exchange of information concerning any of the following: individual company rates, coverages, market practices, claims settlement practices, or any other competitive aspect of an individual company's operation.

At all Global Summit events we require all presenters and hosts to strictly adhere to the letter and spirit of all anti-trust laws. Presentations conducted in person are designed solely to provide a forum for the expression of various points of view on the topic for such presentation. Under no circumstances shall any presentation be used as a means for competing companies or firms to reach any understanding—expressed or implied—which restricts competition or in any way impairs the ability of companies or firms to exercise independent business judgment regarding matters affecting competition. It is the responsibility of all participants to be aware of anti-trust regulations and anti-trust compliance policies and to prevent any type of discussion—written or verbal—that violate the same.
